Teaching: Award in Education and Training Level 3 Parttime

In Brief

Start Date / Duration

The course is planned to start in September 2024. It will run for 12 weeks.

Entry Requirements

- You are expected to hold a Level 3 in your subject specialism although this is not essential
- It is desirable that you have GCSE English Grade 4/C or above or hold a Level 2 in literacy
- You must be aged 19 years or over to study for this qualification

You will take part in an enrolment and information session plus an interview prior to being enrolled onto the programme.

You will achieve

The Award in Education and Training Level 3 accredited by Training Qualifications UK.

(This qualification is a replacement for PTLS).

Course Overview

The Level 3 Award in Education and Training is an introduction to teaching. This will give an insight into the roles, responsibilities and relationships in education and training, how to plan and deliver inclusive teaching sessions and how to assess and give constructive feedback.

Course Content

This award comprises of the three following units which total 12 credits:

- Understanding roles, responsibilities and relationships in education and training (3 credits)
- Understanding and using inclusive approaches in education and training (6 credits)
- Understanding assessment in education and training (3 credits)

How will I be assessed?

You are required to complete written assignments and a micro-teach to be achieved at Level 3.

The assignments are broken down into smaller assessment tasks, which have an emphasis on creative and 'hands on' learning.

What Equipment Will I Need?

You will need to provide your own writing materials, paper and ring binders. A calculator and dictionary are also desirable.

On completion of this course you may wish to look explore Level 4 Education and Training courses.

How much does the course cost?

This course costs £495. There is no funding available for this course, so all learners must pay the full fee. This cost includes the registration and certification fee.
