Management: Team Leading Certificate Level 2 (Online)

In Brief

Start Date / Duration

The course runs at various times throughout the year. Enrolment to this course is now open. You will have 26 weeks to complete the course.

Entry Requirements

- Participants will normally be either practising or aspiring team or cell leaders
- Aged 19+
- GCSE at grade C or above (grade 4 and above) in English and maths or equivalent
- There are no formal educational requirements but learners should have a background that will enable them to benefit from the programme

You will achieve

Level 2 certificate in Team Leading (TKUK)

Course Overview

This level 2 qualification in team leading is designed for aspiring team leaders who wish to develop their team leading skills and knowledge.

Course Content

You will produce a portfolio of evidence to demonstrate your competence in working in a team leading role.

Three mandatory units cover the core skills you need to lead a team. You'll learn how to plan, allocate and monitor work; tools and techniques to develop yourself as a leader; and how to get the most from your team. Then work with your employer and training provider to find the best fit from a wide range of optional units. These cover everything from communication skills to business improvement techniques. The choice includes units from Level 3 qualifications, to help you progress in your career and in formal professional training.

How will I be assessed?

Continuous assessment of evidence produced.

Where will I study?

You will study online.

What can I do next?

Successful learners may progress to a range of qualifications including the following:

- Level 3 Award or Certificate in Leadership and Management
- Level 3 Certificate in Principles of Leadership and Management.
