Discover Barnsley College Library resources with **Discovery**. Not just books but also ebooks, academic journal articles and more. **Discovery** is your 1-stop search for high quality, academic information in print and online. With **Discovery** you can:

- Find books in all Barnsley College libraries
- Access Barnsley College ebooks
- Search for academic journal articles from Barnsley College online collections such as Sage, Taylor & Francis, Springer and Emerald
- Find selected, free academic resources on the Internet

#### How do I access Discovery?

- **Discovery** tile on *MyDay*
- Search from HE Library website: <u>https://www.barnsley.ac.uk/helibrary</u>
- Link from your *MyAthens* list. **Discovery** searches many of the collections listed on *MyAthens*. Resources included in **Discovery** are marked by (D).

## How do I search Discovery?

**Discovery** searches like Google – just type in your search terms. You can look for phrases by using "quotation marks". With **Discovery** you can also use *Search Options* to give you more control over your searches. For example, you can choose to search just for books or ebooks by selecting *Catalogue only*, or just for academic journal articles with *Scholarly (Peer Reviewed) Journals.* 

For expert searches **Discovery** also offers an Advanced Search:

Too many results?	Try more, specific search terms Use Advanced Search and the Boolean/Phrase option to add terms eg children AND obesity
Too few results?	Try fewer, broader search terms Try different search terms or spellings Use Advanced Search and the Boolean/Phrase option to link alternative terms eg (children OR young) AND obesity Truncate terms to look for alternative spellings eg employ* for employee, employees, employment

#### **Results in Discovery**

On the results page, you can further refine you results using the options on the lefthand side.

For example, if you only want books at a particular Barnsley College location you can limit your results to *Catalogue only* and *Limit your Location* to a specific site:
