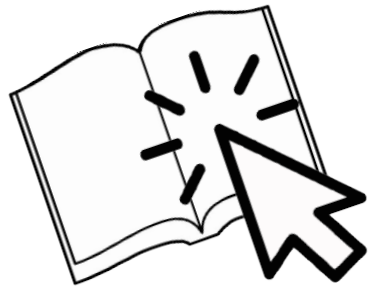


We're almost there...
