# Course Description (including Learning Aims and Objectives)

To support local people in the current financial climate, this classroom-based programme will support students to manage their own finances.

- Be able to handle financial transactions responsibly.

## **Entry Requirements**

The fully-funded training courses are available to anyone aged 19 and over who doesn't currently hold a Maths GCSE at grade C/4. All students will complete an initial and diagnostic maths assessment.

#### **Number of Sessions**

You will complete eight, two hour sessions.

### **Progression Routes**

- Functional Skills Maths, English and ICT (Entry Level Level 2).
- Employability Provision with guaranteed job interviews across various occupational areas.
- Gateway to Work budgeting, mental wellbeing, personal development, personal targets and setting achievable goals.
