

Course Title	Multiply Course: Climb Mount Everest
Training Provider	ITS (Part of Barnsley College)

Course Description (including Learning Aims and Objectives)

To support local people in the current financial climate, this classroom-based course will support students to manage their own finances.

- Be able to research prices for travel, food, accommodation and budget accordingly to a fixed wage.
- Calculate how long it takes to get into climbing condition and if this fits into their fixed time scale (addition, subtraction, division, multiplication).
- Demonstrate the ability to utilise the internet in planning a journey overseas and the activity of climbing Everest.
- Research loans for the total cost of the expedition, compare interest rates, and calculate how long it will take to pay the loan back based on a set income (addition, subtraction, division, multiplication).
- Project manage, work as a team and develop communication skills.

Entry Requirements

The fully-funded training courses are available to anyone aged 19 and over who doesn't currently hold a Maths GCSE at grade C/4. All students will complete an initial and diagnostic maths assessment.

Number of Sessions

One full day.

Progression Routes

- Functional Skills Maths, English and ICT (Entry Level Level 2).
- Employability Provision with guaranteed job interviews across various occupational areas.
- Gateway to Work budgeting, mental wellbeing, personal development, personal targets and setting achievable goals.
