Course Description (including Learning Aims and Objectives)

To support local people in the current financial climate, this classroom-based course will provide useful knowledge on:

- Calculate intake and output of their patient's fluids and food intake.
- Conversions weights, measures and heights.
- Nutrition
- Measuring temperatures on patients and rooms.

Entry Requirements

The fully-funded training courses are available to anyone aged 19 and over who doesn't currently hold a Maths GCSE at grade C/4. All students will complete an initial and diagnostic maths assessment.

Number of Sessions

You will complete eight, two hour sessions.

Progression Routes

- Functional Skills Maths, English and ICT (Entry Level Level 2).
- Employability Provision with guaranteed job interviews across various occupational areas.
- Gateway to Work budgeting, mental wellbeing, personal development, personal targets and setting achievable goals.
