<p>To support local people in the current financial climate, this classroom-based course will support students to manage their own finances.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Investigate local high street deals through teamwork and activities. • Calculate the best/worst savings across a range of products sourced locally. • Are online deals better than deals on the high street? Use calculation methods to identify most efficient deals for every-day products. • Food shopping – are you really saving money? Investigate the value of promotions and deals to calculate savings. • Utilities – how much is it costing you? Is your bill correct? Calculate the cost of energy used and compare a range of energy suppliers.

<p>The fully-funded training courses are available to anyone aged 19 and over who doesn't currently hold a Maths GCSE at grade C/4. All students will complete an initial and diagnostic maths assessment.</p>

Eight two hour sessions.
