Course Description (including Learning Aims and Objectives)

To support local people in the current financial climate, this classroom-based course will support students to manage their own finances.

- Apply basic mathematics in a financial context.
- Understand the language of basic accounting.
- Understand the different roles and responsibilities within accounting.
- Understand how to communicate effectively.
- Understand the advantages of different IT programmes which support accounting.

Entry Requirements

The fully-funded training courses are available to anyone aged 19 and over who doesn't currently hold a Maths GCSE at grade C/4. All students will complete an initial and diagnostic maths assessment.

Number of Sessions

Three one day sessions or 12 two hour sessions.

Progression Routes

- Functional Skills Maths, English and ICT (Entry Level Level 2).
- Employability Provision with guaranteed job interviews across various occupational areas.
- Gateway to Work budgeting, mental wellbeing, personal development, personal targets and setting achievable goals.
