Course Description (including Learning Aims and Objectives)

To support local people in the current financial climate, this classroom-based course will support students to manage their own finances.

- Household budgeting Calculate current costs versus current income.
- Needs and Wants what are they?
- Managing your own money external (expert) speaker will support this session.
- Can you save on money essentials? calculate savings for a range of household costs.
- Food shopping are you really saving money? Investigate the value of promotions and deals to calculate savings.
- Utilities how much is it costing you? Is your bill correct? Calculate the cost of energy used and compare a range of energy suppliers.

Entry Requirements

The fully-funded training courses are available to anyone aged 19 and over who doesn't currently hold a Maths GCSE at grade C/4. All students will complete an initial and diagnostic maths assessment.

Number of Sessions

Eight two hour sessions.

Progression Routes

- Functional Skills Maths, English and ICT (Entry Level Level 2).
- Employability Provision with guaranteed job interviews across various occupational areas.
- Gateway to Work budgeting, mental wellbeing, personal development, personal targets and setting achievable goals.
