# Course Description (including Learning Aims and Objectives)

To support local people in the current financial climate, this classroom-based course will support students to manage their own finances.

- What is credit and what does it cost? Calculate the cost of a range of credit cards, loans and other credit options.
- What is your money personality? Investigate spending patterns and dealing with financial dilemmas.
- Managing your finances, how can I repay debt and how can I avoid it in future? Calculate the cost of some common financial mistakes.
- Utilities how much is it costing you? Is your bill correct? Calculate the cost of energy used and compare a range of energy suppliers and payment options

### **Entry Requirements**

The fully-funded training courses are available to anyone aged 19 and over who doesn't currently hold a Maths GCSE at grade C/4. All students will complete an initial and diagnostic maths assessment.

### **Number of Sessions**

Eight two hour sessions.

#### **Progression Routes**

- Functional Skills Maths, English and ICT (Entry Level Level 2).
- Employability Provision with guaranteed job interviews across various occupational areas.
- Gateway to Work budgeting, mental wellbeing, personal development, personal targets and setting achievable goals.
