

## **Terms and Conditions**

1. The competition is being run by Barnsley Libraries in partnership with Barnsley College's Wigfield Farm.
2. The competition is open to those aged 12 and under only and residents of Yorkshire. Proof of age, identity and eligibility may be requested.
3. Entries are free.
4. Entries must be an original piece of work consisting of no more than 500 words.
5. Entries can be scanned and emailed to [BarnsleyLibraryEnquiries@Barnsley.gov.uk](mailto:BarnsleyLibraryEnquiries@Barnsley.gov.uk); delivered to one of the libraries in Barnsley; posted into the submission box at the Wigfield Farm Summer Show; or handed to a Barnsley Library representative at Wigfield Farm.
6. Entries can be typed or handwritten. Please complete an entry form or include the following information in your email: Name, Address and Telephone Number.
7. The closing date for entries is Sunday 20 August 2023, 11.59pm.
8. Entries received after Sunday 20 August 2023, 11.59pm, will not be considered.
9. The winner will be contacted by telephone number on Friday 25 August 2023.
10. Entries cannot be returned so please keep a copy for your records.
11. The judge's decision is final. No feedback can be given on submitted works.
12. The first round of judging will take place by Barnsley Library staff before being submitted to Barnsley College for a further round of judging by a College representative.
13. Entries must not contain defamatory, obscene, offensive or other unsuitable material and should be suitable to be read, published or used online for audiences of all ages.
14. Entries will be judged on originality and how well they capture the theme of the competition.
15. The theme of the competition is 'Once Upon a Time at the Farm', all entries must use this as their central theme.
16. Participants must be willing to allow their works to be published online or in a booklet in keeping with the wishes of Barnsley Libraries. Full credit for works will be given to the authors.
17. Any entry which breaches these terms and conditions will be eliminated.
18. The prize will be a printed copy of their own book and a Wigfield Farm exclusive hamper.
19. We reserve the right to amend any of these terms and conditions or cancel the competition at any point if necessary.
