Course Overview

This qualification allows you to develop the skills needed to become an effective mentor

Course Content

The course will cover the following areas:

- The role and practice of mentorship including the relationship between the mentor and the mentee and following good practice.
- Developing the specific skills and understanding needed to become a mentor
- The benefits of mentoring
- Legal and ethical mentoring requirements
- Reflection on your own learning and work performance

To be awarded the NCFE Level 2 Award in Mentoring, learners are required to successfully complete 3 mandatory units.

Mandatory units

- Role of a mentor
- Preparing for the role of a mentor
- Demonstrating mentoring skills and techniques

How will I be assessed?

You will produce a portfolio of evidence, which demonstrates achievement of all the learning outcomes and assessment criteria associated with each unit.
