Start Date / Duration

This study programme starts in September and is studied over two years.

Entry Requirements

- Five GCSEs at grade 4 or above including English and Maths.
- Where applicants do not meet the entry requirements, the tutor may use their discretion based on a good personal reference and/or successful interview.

Course Overview

This two year course has been designed with employers to give you the industry skills you need in order to start your career within digital business services.

Whilst studying with specialist tutors, support staff and Work Placements Co-ordinators, you will also be required to complete an industry placement of at least 45 days – providing the real-world experience needed for this industry.

Course Content

Course themes:

The objectives of this qualification are to equip students with:

- The core knowledge and skills relevant to digital business services
- Up-to-date occupational knowledge and skills that have continued currency amongst employers and others
- English, Maths and Digital skills
- Threshold competence that meets employer expectations and is as close to full occupational competence as possible

You will study:

- Sourcing, organising and formatting data securely in a relevant way for analysis

- Blending data from multiple sources
- Analysing structured and unstructured data to support business outcomes
- Interpreting data and communicating a result appropriate to the audience
- Applying legal, ethical and professional principles when manipulating data
- Discovering, evaluating, and applying reliable sources of knowledge
