In Brief

Start Date / Duration

The course starts in September 2024 and lasts for one year.

Entry Requirements

Two GCSEs at grade 4 or above, preferably including English and/or Maths or four GCSEs at grade 3 including English and/or Maths.

Or completion of the Level 1 Certificate in Travel and Tourism plus GCSE English and Maths at grade 3. You will achieve

Level 2 Adventure Tourism Certificate.

Course Overview

The Travel and Tourism industry offers a vast range of jobs, taking you to all corners of the globe. If you'd like to follow a career in a dynamic and challenging industry that offers lots of variety and employment opportunities at all levels, this course could be perfect for you.

Adventure Tourism is one of the largest growing tourism industries, with more and more people looking to spend time outdoors on adventures away from and close to home. This course will support you to understand the adventure industry through a range of trips, visits and adventure activities; such as hiking, climbing, abseiling, kayaking, gorge walking and more! Utilising the local area, the Peak District and national parks, you will get the chance to fully immerse yourself into the outdoor adventure experience.

Course Content

The course themes are:

• Planning and leading adventure activities

- The guided tour
- Adventure expeditions
- Creating an adventure package
- Volunteering and customer service skills

How will I be assessed?

Assessment methods are mainly assignment-based and may include practical projects including presentations, group activities, written reports and role-plays. Some units will also require you to complete an end-of-unit test.

What Equipment Will I Need?

You will need to provide stationery for class-based sessions. For the outdoor activities, appropriate clothing will be required (e.g. waterproof jacket, appropriate footwear for hiking and a rucksack).
