Course Overview

Our Fashion and Textile T Level qualification has been designed in partnership with employers to give you the industry skills you need in order to start your career within the fashion industry.

You will complete an industry placement of at least 45 days – providing you with real-world experience. T Levels offer you a mixture of classroom learning and 'on-the-job' experience.

Course Content

Course themes:

- Creative economy
- Cultural context
- Research skills
- Professionalism and ethics
- Diversity and inclusion
- Analysing, interpreting and responding to a creative proposition or a given brief taking on board purpose and end user
- Refining and communicating ideas for product development
- Experimenting with materials, processes, tools and techniques to determine suitability for purpose
- Using selected materials and applying appropriate processes, tools and techniques, to realise ideas and fulfil the brief

• Reviewing and evaluating the activities and development against the original brief or proposition to refine product(s)

How will I be assessed?

T Levels are assessed through a mixture of coursework, examination and your industry placement.
