You will achieve a Level 1 Award in Computerised Accounting for Business. (Skills First)

Course Overview

This qualification provides you with an introduction to computerised accounting software, bookkeeping and banking procedures.

The **SAGE Accounting** course provides underpinning knowledge of double entry bookkeeping and the principles of banking procedures using a computerised accounting application. This is a great introduction ahead of progressing to further computerised accounting / payroll courses or AAT qualifications.

As part of the course, you will be provided with access to *Sage software and course materials on an online portal so that you can study outside of class time at a time to suit you. Resources available will include formative and practice simulations andworkshops will be held on **Tuesdays**1.30-4.30pm where a tutor will be available to support you and answer any questions.

*software is not compatible with Windows XP or Apple Macs – unless you are running Windows Vista or Windows 7 via Apple's Boot Camp utility

The course will give you the most up to date skills that will enhance your employability or help you to run the finances of your own business.

- Using a computerised accounting application
- Introduction to book-keeping
- Working within book-keeping
- Banking procedures

Eligibility for Funding

Part-time courses are only available for learners who are 19 years old and above. You may not have to pay for this course if you are employed but earn below £21,255 a year, or if you receive Job Seekers Allowance, Employment and Support Allowance or Universal Credit. If you are unemployed, actively seeking employment and receive Council Tax Benefit, Housing Benefit, Income Support or WFTC then you may also receive funding for this course. You will need to provide evidence of your eligibility which will be checked at enrolment.

This course is funded by South Yorkshire Mayoral Combined Authority (SYMCA) and/or West Yorkshire Combined Authority (WYCA). You must be living in the South or West Yorkshire regions to qualify for funding.
