Accounting (SAGE) Level 2 Part-time

In Brief

Start Date / Duration Entry Requirements You will achieve

Starting September 2024, classes run on a Tuesday 1.30pm-4.30pm for 10 weeks. SAGE Level 1 Accounting

You will achieve a Level 2 Certificate in Computerised Accounting for Business. (Skills First)

Course Overview

This Level 2 qualification is ideal if you have some existing knowledge and understanding of computerised accounting, but little experience of manual bookkeeping concepts. It enables learners to achieve vocationally focused skills and knowledge related to the computerised accounting process.



Course Content

The units you will study are:

- Banking procedures
- Principles of recording and processing financial transactions
- Principles of VAT
- Professional values and basic business legislation
- Setting up accounting software to manage accounting information
- Processing routine payments and receipts using a computerised system
- Maintaining and recording the cash book
- Maintaining the journal

How will I be assessed?

You will create a portfolio of evidence.

Eligibility for Funding

Part-time courses are only available for learners who are 19 years old and above. You may not have to pay for this course if you are employed but earn below £21,255 a year, or if you receive Job Seekers Allowance, Employment and Support Allowance or Universal Credit. If you are unemployed, actively seeking employment and receive Council Tax Benefit, Housing Benefit, Income Support or WFTC then you may also receive funding for this course. You will need to provide evidence of your eligibility which will be checked at enrolment.

This course is funded by South Yorkshire Mayoral Combined Authority (SYMCA) and/or West Yorkshire Combined Authority (WYCA). You must be living in the South or West Yorkshire regions to qualify for funding.
