Course Overview

The purpose of the qualification is to develop your knowledge and understanding of customer service.

Course Content

To achieve this qualification, you will study three mandatory units and choose four optional units from the list below:

Mandatory Units

- Principles of customer service
- Understand customers
- Understand employer organisations

Optional Units

- Developing working relationships with colleagues
- Handling objections and closing sales
- Processing information about customers
- Principles of Equality and Diversity in the workplace
- Understanding the delivery of online customer service
- Understanding how to communicate with customers using the telephone
- Understanding how to communicate with customers verbally and in writing
- Understanding how to develop customer relationships
- Understanding how to process and follow up sales orders

- Understanding how to resolve customer service problems and challenges

You will create a portfolio of evidence.

If you are unemployed, actively seeking employment and receive Council Tax Benefit, Housing Benefit, Income Support or WFTC then you may also receive funding for this course. You will need to

provide evidence of your eligibility which will be checked at enrolment.
