This course will start in February. Apply for further details. It will run on Tuesday evenings, 5.30pm-9.00pm.

Entry Requirements

Entry to this course will require you to hold at least a Level 1 or equivalent qualification and you should have a good level of English.

You will achieve

You will achieve a VTCT Level 2 Award in Manicure Services.

Course Overview

This course is designed to develop your knowledge and skills in providing a manicure service. Manicures are a timeless treatment and being qualified in providing this service could open new career opportunities for you.

Course Content

As part of this course, you will study:

- Health and safety
- Consultation and product knowledge
- Manicure treatment
- Additional treatments (Hand mask, paraffin wax mask and hot oil)
- French and dark polish
- Science – skin, nail structure, bones/muscles of the hand/ arm, blood, and lymphatic system

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed by completing written tasks and tests, plus successfully completing a practical assessment.

What Equipment Will I Need?

To study this course, you will need:

- Manicure equipment (This will be provided, but you can purchase it if you wish)
- Professional uniform
- Pens, paper and folder

More details about equipment and uniform will be shared with you upon enrolment.
