## Children and Young Peoples Workforce Level 2 Work-based

### In Brief

#### Start Date / Duration

This course has various start times throughout the year and will be completed in 36 weeks.

#### Entry Requirements

There are no formal qualifications for this award; however you must be a volunteer, a childminder or currently employed in an OFSTED inspected environment – **having experience in an Early Years setting.**

- An initial assessment for Numeracy and Literacy will take place on application to the course
- Students will normally take part in an interview prior to being enrolled on the programme

#### You will achieve

Level 2 Certificate for Children and Young People's Workforce (QCF) (35 credits)

### Course Overview

These qualifications are designed for learners who want to develop a career as a childminder, youth worker, nursery nurse or nursery manager. Level 2 will suit you if you work, or are about to work, in a supporting role as a nursery assistant, Crèche worker or special educational needs assistant. You want to work with children, but you'll generally work under supervision.

### Course Content

The QCF allows learners to build up credits which are made up of a number of units that have a stated aim. Each unit is made up from learning outcomes and each learning outcome is linked to a

number of assessment criteria. Each of the assessments criteria must be completed successfully for a learner to achieve the unit. Each unit has a level and credit value.

#### Core Mandatory Units:

- Introduction to communication in health, social care or children's and young people's settings
- Introduction to personal development in health social care or children and young people's
- Introduction to equality and inclusion in health, social care or children and young people's
- Child and young people's development
- Safeguard the welfare of children and young people
- Maintain and support relationships with children and young people
- Support children and young people's positive behaviour
- Contribute to children and young people's safety
- Contribute to the support of the positive environments children and young people
- Understand partnership working in services for children and young people
- Paediatric emergency first aid
- Paediatric illness and injury

#### Optional Units:

You will choose from a variety of optional units depending on your own role and responsibility in the workplace. These will build up the remaining credits to achieve the full Level 2 Certificate

## How will I be assessed?

Through Work based Assessments in your work placement and various evidence methods throughout the programme, building up a portfolio.

## What Equipment Will I Need?

You will be required to provide paper, writing materials, A4 ring binder file, extra wide dividers and clear plastic wallets. A copy of the standard handbook will be provided and given to you by your assessor on the first visit.
