# Animal Care and Management T Level (Technical Qualification) Level 3 Full-time

# In Brief

This course will start in September and will run for two years. Five GCSEs at grade 5 or above including English, Maths and Science.

# **Course Overview**

T Levels are courses for 16 to 18 year olds that are studied at the same level as doing A Levels. They are for young people who prefer a more technical education when they come to College, rather than following a purely academic pathway, or a work-based apprenticeship.

T Levels provide a mixture of:

- Technical knowledge and practical skills specific to the student's chosen industry or occupation.
- An industry placement of at least 45 days in their chosen industry or occupation.
- Relevant Maths, English and digital skills.
- Common workplace skills.

Students who achieve a T Level will get a nationally recognised certificate which employers will use as evidence in their recruitment.

T Levels will offer students a mixture of classroom or workshop-based learning and 'on-the-job' experience.

#### **Course Content**

This course is ideal for you if you wish to pursue a career in the Animal Care industry. The purpose of the T Level is to ensure you have the knowledge and skills needed to progress into skilled employment, higher-level technical training or a university programme within the sector.

You will develop an understanding of a broad range of issues relevant to the sector.

Core Topics include:

- Sustainability
- Ethics
- Business Management
- Health and Safety
- Customer Care

Specialism Modules will cover:

- Animal Biology
- Health and Disease
- Nutrition and Feeding
- Animal Behaviour
- Animal Training
- Animal Welfare

#### How will I be assessed?

Over the two years, you will be required to complete three exams, an employer set project and a synoptic assessment.

In addition, you must complete an industry placement, lasting a minimum of 315 hours.

# What Equipment Will I Need?

All students on landbased programmes are required to wear standard uniform and also PPE for practical work in the form of steel toe capped boots and overalls.
