Two GCSEs at grade 4 or above **plus** English at grade 3 or above.

On completion of the course you will achieve Pearson BTEC Level 2 First Award in Business.

Course Overview

This course is perfect if you're looking for a career in the world of business as it provides an overview of some of the wide range of options available, within this industry. This course will allow you to gain a broad knowledge and understanding of the business sector. You will plan your own business start-up. You will learn about the different types of ownership and organisational structures and decide which is the best option for your business.

You will have the opportunity to enhance your employability skills by participating in work experience and you will work as part of a team to raise funds for a local charity.

Students are able to re-sit GCSE English and/or Maths at the same time as studying this course.

Course Content

You can expect to develop employability and enterprise skills from experienced, friendly tutors with a wealth of industry experience. You will also gain a broad range of skills needed for the business world.

You will cover a range of topics including:

- Introduction to business
- Enterprise in the business world
- Finance for business
- Customer service
- Teamwork
- Business communication

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed by a combination of one external exam, course work and practical assessed units to demonstrate competency within the field of business.
