### Course Overview

Motor vehicle technicians repair and service cars, vans, motorbikes, lorries and coaches. They work on all vehicle mechanics and electrics, from engines and exhaust systems to air-conditioning and security.

For individuals who love to be around cars, becoming a motor vehicle technician is a dream job. Motor vehicle technicians repair and tune engines to maximum running efficiency, install parts and accessories, and repair dented body panels.

### Course Content

The topics you will study are as follows:

- Automotive vehicle workshop practices.
- Inspection of vehicles.
- Diagnose and rectify faults in engines systems.
- Diagnose and rectify faults in chassis systems.
- Diagnose and rectify faults in transmission systems.
- Employability rights and responsibilities and health and safety legislation.
- Applied Maths, Electronics, Science and ICT.
