Level 3 Diploma in Construction and the Built Environment

Course Overview

The Diploma in Construction and the Built Environment provides you with the underpinning knowledge and basic skills needed in a wide range of industry areas. It explores the built environment in terms of its economic, social and environmental impact on both individuals and communities. This Diploma also looks at the different demands made upon land use over time as well as the activities which shape, develop and influence the built environment. The Construction and the Built Environment Diploma provides an understanding of how this key sector works from the inside out.

You will study at our purpose built Construction Centre on the Honeywell Campus. The Centre opened in 2015 and accommodates students studying a range of construction trades, including brickwork, plumbing, plastering, joinery, painting and decorating.

- The Centre, also known as The CUBE, houses innovative and inspiring work areas with industry-led equipment, providing a high quality learning experience for students. Facilities include:
- Workshops
- CAD suite with Architectural software (CAD and BIM)
- A project workshop for new construction technologies
- Break-out areas allowing students to work independently.

Course Content

You will study 12 units over 2 years.

The 6 mandatory units are:

- Health, Safety and Welfare in Construction and the Built Environment
- Sustainable Construction
- Maths in Construction and the Built Environment
- Science and Materials in Construction and the Built Environment
- Construction Technology and Design in Construction and Civil Engineering
- Building Technology in Construction

Some of the optional units are:

- Project Management in Construction
- Building Surveying
- Building Regulations and Control
- Computer Aided Design for Construction
- Property Law
- Conversion and Adaptations of Buildings

How will I be assessed?

All the units are assessed through assignment work. This will include written reports, presentations, group work, and other methods.

You will require pens, paper, drawing equipment, scientific calculator and identified text books.
