In Brief

Start Date / Duration

This course commences in September 2024 and runs for one year. A timetable showing days and times of classes will be assigned at the start of the programme.

Entry Requirements

Successful completion of a Level 2 qualification in Beauty Therapy **OR** Level 2 qualification in Make-up Artistry.

You will achieve Make-up Artistry Advanced Technical Diploma Level 3.

Course Overview

This course is perfect if you have a keen interest in and a real flair for the application of make-up.

You will learn the specific advanced skills which will be of particular interest if you wish to enter the film and TV industry as a Make-up Artist.

Makeup artists have the freedom to be as creative as they want. You can choose what you want to specialize in. Weddings and special occasions, photo shoots, TV and movie productions, the options are endless. Each model is a fresh new canvas that allows you to express yourself as an artist

This course is aimed at those students who have a keen interest and a real flair in the application of make-up. This course is perfect if you've developed some make up application skills and want to get the qualifications you need for a career as a professional make up artist, providing services within the media, fashion and photographic industries.

Course Content

Course themes:

- Fashion and photography
- Media make-up and creative hair designs
- Creating historical and make-up looks

- Applying make-up
- Camouflaging make-up
- Instructing make-up

How will I be assessed?

There will be continuous assessment of practical work, both on and off the job, oral questioning relating to practical work and written questions. You will be required to maintain and submit a portfolio of evidence of work produced. Assessments are based on the ability to do the job.

What Equipment Will I Need?

You will be required to purchase a uniform, fashion and photographic and media make-up kit. All kits are compulsory to attend the course and achieve the qualification. Further information will be provided at interview.
