**This course is an introduction to hairdressing. You will learn the skills required to assist stylists in their role and carry out treatments within a commercial salon environment.**

Alongside this course you will also gain additional qualifications and personal and social development skills.

### Course Content

The course is an assisting role covering the following themes:

- Salon reception duties
- Shampoo and conditioning hair
- Blow drying
- Styling hair
- Health and safety
- Plaiting hair

## How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed by online and practical assessments.
