Course Overview

Barnsley College and South Yorkshire Fire and Rescue have teamed up with the Prince's Trust to deliver the Team programme, a 12-week personal development programme offering a residential in the Peak District, a community project, practical work experience and practical support from local employers to ensure you stand out throughout your job search.

All of this is delivered from the purpose-built Prince's Trust Team Room at Barnsley Fire Station.

Alongside the Prince's Trust Qualification, you will have the opportunity to gain the following qualifications:

 Level 2 Food Safety in Catering Level 2 Health and Safety A practical First Aid award

You will also get to meet the South Yorkshire Fire Crews and South Yorkshire Police and learn about their jobs, plus many other once-in-a-lifetime opportunities.

Course Content

So what's involved?

Day 1: Meet new people

Don't worry about turning up on your own – there'll be about 15 people joining and everyone will be in the same situation. It'll be informal and there are plenty of activities so you'll soon feel part of the group.

Week 1: Take action

Over this week, you'll start planning for the weeks ahead – setting out what you want to achieve and finding out how to get your qualifications.

Week 2: New experiences

You'll spend this week away – trying new things and learning how to work with others. This gives you a chance to break away from your current situation – trying canoeing, climbing, raft-building and much more.

Weeks 3-6: Something to talk about

As a Team, you'll decide on a project to benefit your local community and carry it out. This gives you great experience to talk about at interviews.

Weeks 7-8: Work placements

This is the time to see how the skills you've developed so far can help you in the workplace. It's also a great chance to try out a type of work, or company, to see whether you like it.

Week 9: Plan for the future

You'll get help to write a fantastic CV, practice your interview skills and write applications.

Weeks 10-11: Meet the challenge

You and your Team will take on a challenge to help others in the community. This is when you get to test out all the skills you've developed.

Week 12: Have your say

In your final week, you'll deliver a presentation – giving you the chance to show off the talents you've discovered! This may sound scary now, but after 12 weeks you'll be surprised at how far you've come.

How will I be assessed?

There is no assessment, just attendance.

What Equipment Will I Need?

All equipment and resources will be provided.

Where will I study?

What can I do next?

Whilst there is no direct progression, successful candidates have the skills and confidence to apply for work or study.

How much does the course cost?

This course is free.

16 – 18 year olds
