This programme starts in September and will take one year to complete.

You will need to hold two GCSEs in English and Maths. These must be at Grade 3 or above.

Course Overview

At Barnsley College's Construction Centre [https://www.barnsley.ac.uk/campuses/construction-centre/], you will learn essential bricklaying skills such as constructing walls, piers, fireplaces, and chimneys. You will also gain knowledge in reading construction drawings, organising and planning projects, and pricing construction work. The course covers health and safety in construction and develops employability skills like teamwork, communication, CV writing, and self-management. It also includes practical training in site carpentry and plastering.

Course Content

The duration of the course covers the following units in technical knowledge understanding and practical training and development in the following areas:

Introduction to health and safety in construction
Principles of building construction, information and communication
Carry out first fix flooring and roofing
Carry out first fix frames, partitions and stairs
Carry out second fixing operation

How will I be assessed?

There will be assessment windows throughout your the study programme where your knowledge, understanding and practical skills will be assessed under exam conditions. You will achieve either a

Pass, Merit or Distinction grade.

What Equipment Will I Need?

Basic stationery for the classroom activities.
