Course Overview

This qualification develops your existing skills and knowledge to an advanced level, either to gain employment or as a route to Qualified Bookkeeper status (AATQB). It is an ideal qualification to achieve in order to progress to higher level accounting qualifications or an accounting apprenticeship.

Learners who excel in this qualification will be given the opportunity to do the extra modules to gain the AAT qualification.

Course Content

You will study the following modules:

- Indirect Tax
- Advanced Bookkeeping
- Final Accounts Preparation

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed by a computerised based examination after the completion of each core unit, with a final synoptic assessment that assesses knowledge and understanding from across the qualification.
