Childcare: Transition to Playwork Level 3 Work-based

In Brief

Start Date / Duration

This course runs at various times throughout the year and will take up to twelve months to complete.

Entry Requirements

- Learners will need to be at least 18 years of age and hold a Level 3 Early Years qualification
- You need to be employed or volunteering within the childcare/playwork setting
- As your programme may involve working with children, you will be required to undertake a satisfactory Disclosure Barring Service (DBS) check

You will achieve

You will achieve a Level 3 Award in Transition to Playwork (from Early Years).

Course Overview

This course is ideal for Early Years practitioners who would like to broaden their knowledge and work in playwork settings.

Course Content

This qualification is based on the National Occupational Standards for Playwork and will develop the knowledge needed when working in playwork settings. It covers the theories and principles of play and playwork, risk management and how to support the needs and rights of children to create diverse play environments.

Mandatory Units

- Understand aspects of Playwork practice
- Understand the theories underpinning Playwork practice

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed by your assessor using a portfolio of evidence, observations in the workplace and assessment tasks.

What Equipment Will I Need?

The course is an E-portfolio using OneFile, access to a computer/laptop and internet will be required. If this is not suitable, a paper base portfolio could be accessed.

Where will I study?

You will study within the workplace and access your portfolio online. You will be allocated an assessor for support.

What can I do next?

Upon completion of the CACHE Award Transition into Playwork Level 3 qualification, learners can progress onto Level 3 Diploma in Playwork (NVQ) (QCF).

You could progress your career in the sector. Playworkers can work in a wide range of environments including:

- After School Clubs Practitioner
- Adventure Playgrounds Practitioner
- Holiday Clubs Practitioner
- Hospitals Playwork Practitioner

How much does the course cost?
